Matariki Buddy Art with Room 7 and Room 19

Last week, the seniors spent some time with Room 7 and Room 19. Working with them as tuakana-teina. They helped us to create some art based around Matariki.

Room 7 - We wove coloured paper strips onto a Matariki inspired word art background. We had to carefully choose a colour to weave through that would complement our background (to do this we learnt that we need to select a colour from the opposite side of the colour wheel). Then we chose a template of a traditional Māori design, traced around it on black paper, cut out the shape in the middle and glued it onto our weaving.
